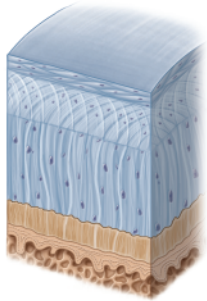
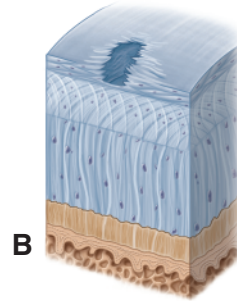
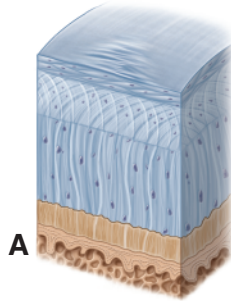


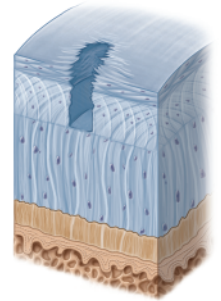
ICRS Grade 0 – Normal



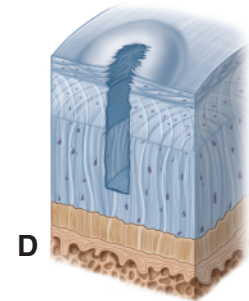
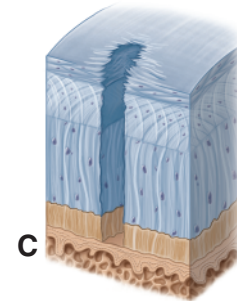
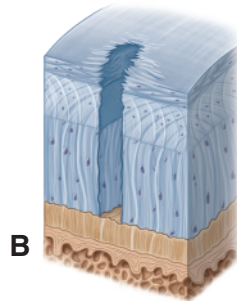
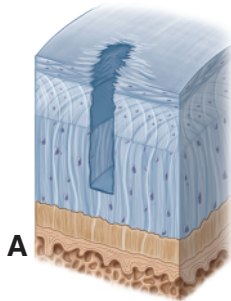
ICRS Grade 1 – Nearly Normal
Superficial lesions. Soft indentation (A)
and/or superficial fissures and cracks (B)



ICRS Grade 2 – Abnormal
Lesions extending down to
<50% of cartilage depth



ICRS Grade 3 – Severely Abnormal
Cartilage defects extending down to >50% of cartilage depth (A) as well as down to calcified layer (B)
but not through the subchondral bone (C). Blisters are included in this Grade (D)



ICRS Grade 4 – Severely Abnormal
