FOCUS MEETING & SKILLS COURSE ON KNEE OSTEOTOMIES

incl. 4 Hands-on Surgical Skills Workshops on Dry Bones Date: March 7 - 9, 2024

Place: Whitworth Hall, University of Manchester, UK Organizers: Leela Biant, Mike McNicholas

This course will give a comprehensive lecture and practicalbased education in osteotomy for all aspects of joint preservation. There will be novel learning opportunities with our vet colleagues who have vast experience with osteotomy for instability. Delegates will learn the biology and biomechanics of osteotomy, indications for surgery, multiple-level osteotomy, and the role of osteotomy in combination with other joint preservation strategies. The importance of planning and the latest technology-assisted planning improvements in accuracy and reliability will be discussed. Delegates can do hands-on sessions with planning tools and dry bone surgery for the commonly employed techniques. The faculty will share tips on how to minimise potential complications and treat those that occur. Rehabilitation, return to sport, assessment of outcome, the long-term results, and implications for the future of the joint will be outlined.

Advanced imaging technology, particularly Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI), has become crucial in the field of cartilage repair, aiding in pre-surgery treatment decisions, post-surgery outcome assessment, and evaluation of new repair techniques. The seminal MOCART Score developed two decades ago in Vienna, remains a pivotal tool for systematic cartilage repair analysis. This course aims to explore advancements in surgical technology, new imaging scoring systems, and compositional MR methods while promoting education and science in cartilage repair on a global scale. The event will be enriched by Vienna's cultural heritage, offering both scientific enlightenment and cultural enjoyment.

FOCUS MEETING PATIENT PROFILING IN CARTILAGE REGENERATION & ASPECTS OF JUVENILE CARTILAGE

Date: December 12 - 14, 2024

Why do we accept an 80% success rate for almost all treatments and surgical procedures for cartilage regeneration even less with rigorous follow-up? Is this a given fact, or can we do better? What are the reasons? Are our interventions of limited benefit? Does the procedure not match the patient, or is our knowledge limited? A comprehensive ICRS Focus Meeting will address those questions, maybe offer some answers and will help doctors, physiotherapists, and sports scientists a.o. to get better in the field of cartilage regeneration. Although much focus has been placed in recent years on the efficacy and efficiency of various techniques for the treatment of cartilage damage in the knee joint, the indication and selection of patients is the most important parameter in the process of cartilage regenerative therapy.

In addition, during this double-event, we want to look closely at juvenile cartilage issues and how treatment strategies and outcomes evolved over the years. Is there a need for early surgical intervention, or should we hold on to conservative treatments as long as possible? Do patients' sex or activity levels play a prognostic role in this context? High-profile discussion panels will seek to put an answer to those questions.
