## ICRS PATIENT REGISTRY ACHIEVEMENTS & OPPORTUNITIES - 2025 BULLETIN

### Celebrating Our Achievements in 2025

The ICRS Patient Registry has made significant strides in 2025, strengthening its status as a global resource for musculoskeletal research and clinical practice. Supported by strong sponsors, cutting-edge technology upgrades, and global outreach, the Registry consistently supports clinicians, generates data-driven insights, and encourages collaboration among stakeholders. This bulletin highlights key milestones, innovative features, user growth, and emerging opportunities for sponsors and collaborators.

### KEY MILESTONES

- **Global Expansion:** Over 200 active users across 16 countries! We had a robust organic user growth, welcoming over 50 new users from diverse regions.
- **New language translations:** The long-awaited French translation went live, facilitating participation from Canadian and other French-speaking clinicians.
- **Delivery of two Annual Sponsor Reports:** Arthrex and Contura's annual report on their product data, highlighting our commitment to fostering collaborations with the Industry while boosting our data growth.
- **Monthly Metrics & Data Quality Oversight:** Introduction of comprehensive monthly reports tracking users, pathways, consent rates, and patient-reported outcomes benchmarks.
- **Showcasing Top-Quality User Support:** Technical assistance for onboarding and troubleshooting was provided to users and institutions worldwide. Customized solutions addressed local regulations, ethical approvals, and integration with hospital systems.
- **Survey Initiatives:** Inactive user surveys and feedback mechanisms were launched to identify barriers and inform strategic enhancements to the Registry platform and user experience.

### **Innovative Features:**

- Enhanced Patient Portal: Major updates include bilateral knee condition support and improved multifactor authentication.

- **Hospital Partnerships:** Ongoing dialogue for Registry implementation in top-notch orthopaedic and research institutions.


